The Master of Public Health program is designed to prepare competent public health professionals with advanced knowledge in

The 2-year MPH program emphasizes evidence-based practice, research methodology, and practical application of public health principles to address contemporary health challenges in India and globally.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates seeking admission to the MPH program must fulfil the following eligibility requirements:

1. Educational Qualification:

- Bachelor's degree in Agriculture, Medicine, AYUSH, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy, Veterinary Sciences, Physiotherapy, or Allied Health Sciences from a recognized Institute / University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate, (or)
- Bachelor's degree in Technology (B. Tech), Public Health (BPH), Business Administration (BBA) or Law (LLB) from a recognized Institute / University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate, (or)
- Bachelor's degree in Science / Life Science / Statistics / Economics / Nutrition / Demography from a recognized Institute / University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate
- All the above qualifications must be from Universities/Institutions recognized by UGC or Government of India.
- Those candidates with prior public health experience will be given

preference for admission in case of a tie in the academic profile/performance in the entrance examination.

2. Minimum Academic Performance:

- Graduate from any recognized University/ Institution of National Importance with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade (45% marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes).

3. Nationality

- Indian nationals
- Foreign nationals (subject to Government of India regulations and availability of supernumerary seats)

4. Age

- No upper age limit
- Candidates must be at least 20 years of age at the time of admission

Selection Stages

1. Statement of Purpose (SOP): 20 marks
(For more Details: Refer to Appendix A)
2. Entrance Examination: 100 marks
 - Format: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) based objective test
 - Total Questions: 100 questions, 1 (one) mark each
 - No Negative Marks
 - Duration: 60 minutes
3. Personal Interview: 30 marks

Total: 150 marks

Qualifying Criterion: A Minimum of 50% marks is required to be eligible for admission

Examination Centers:

The entrance examination will be conducted at the following five centers for candidates' convenience:

- Hyderabad, Telangana
- Bhubaneswar, Odisha
- Bangalore, Karnataka
- New Delhi / NCR, Delhi
- Gandhinagar, Gujarat

Candidates will have the option to select their preferred examination centre during the application process. The Institute reserves the right to rationalise examination centres based on the number of registrations.

Final Merit List

Determination of Merit: The final selection will be based on:

- Performance in the entrance examination: 50% weightage
- Performance in the personal interview: 30% weightage
- Statement of Purpose and academic record: 20% weightage

Announcement: The final merit list will be announced on the Institute website and communicated to eligible candidates as per the announced timeline.

Inter-Se Merit: In the event of tie marks, the inter-se merit for selection shall be determined as follows:

- Candidate securing higher marks in the entrance examination
- Candidate with higher marks in the personal interview
- Candidate with higher score in academic record (Bachelor's degree marks)
- In case of continued tie, the candidate appearing older in age shall be given preference

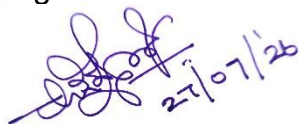

2. Career Objectives (100-150 words)

 - Area(s) of specialization or interest within public health
 - Career aspirations post-completion of MPH
3. Relevance to Public Health (100-150 words)
 - Your understanding of public health challenges in India
 - Specific areas of public health you wish to address
 - Your perspective on how public health professionals can contribute to national health goals
4. Commitment and Motivation (80-100 words)
 - Why MPH program aligns with your career plans
 - Your commitment to public health practice and service
 - How you envision contributing to the public health sector

Format:

- Font: Times New Roman or Arial, 12-point
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Margin: 1-inch on all sides
- Page limit: Maximum 2 pages, single-sided printing

Appendix B: Entrance Examination Best Practices:
